**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE FISCAL
YEAR 2022 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
PERFORMANCE GRANT AND AMMENDING THE FISCAL
YEAR 2023/2024 ADOPTED BUDGET REVENUE AND
EXPENDITURES BY \$40,866.**

WHEREAS, The City of San Bernardino is a participating jurisdiction in the Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) and has used funds from the program to purchase equipment that enables the City to better prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from emergency events and natural disasters; and

WHEREAS, on July, 26 2023, the Police Department received notification that the City was awarded \$40,866 in EMPG funds from the Fiscal Year 2022 grant project.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to accept the Fiscal Year 2022 EMPG grant in the amount of \$40,866 and execute any documents as may be necessary to accept grant funds.

SECTION 3. The Director of Finance and Management Services is hereby authorized to amend the FY2023/2024 Adopted Budget , appropriating \$40,866 in revenue and expenditures.

SECTION 4. The Mayor and City Council finds this Resolution is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in that the activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty, as in this case, that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA.

SECTION 5. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
