

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-224

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE 2024 DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES GRANT, THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES TO AMEND THE FY 2024/25 ADOPTED BUDGET WITH AN APPROPRIATION OF \$625,000.00 IN BOTH REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES IN GRANT FUNDS AND \$432,439.30 IN GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES IN GRANT MATCH REQUIREMENTS, AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO INCREASE SWORN STAFFING FROM 311 TO 316.

WHEREAS, The City of San Bernardino has been awarded the 2024 Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program Grant in the amount of \$625,000.00, and,

WHEREAS, The City will use the funding to promote community policing efforts and reduce gun related violent crime.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the 2024 Department of Justice Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program Grant in the amount of \$625,000 for the grant period October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2029.

SECTION 3. The Director of Project and Management Services is hereby authorized to amend the FY2024/25 Adopted Budget with an appropriation of \$625,000 in both revenue and expenditure for grant funds and a General Fund match requirement of \$432,439.30 in expenditures.

SECTION 4. The Police Department is hereby authorized to increase sworn staffing from 311 to 316, effective October 1, 2024.

SECTION 5. That the City Council finds this Resolution is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in that the activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty, as in this case, that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA.

SECTION 6. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
