

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-204

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT GRANT AWARD FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FOR THE BLOOMBERG CENTER OF PUBLIC INNOVATION 2.0 PROJECT (LOVE YOUR BLOCK GRANT); AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A SUBAWARD AGREEMENT AND ANY SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS WITH JOHNS HOPKINS UNIVERSITY (JHU) FOR THE BLOOMBERG CENTER OF PUBLIC INNOVATION 2.0 PROJECT (LOVE YOUR BLOCK GRANT) TO CARRY OUT THE SERVICE DELIVERABLES FOR THE PERIOD OF MAY 1, 2024 THROUGH APRIL 30, 2026; AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE & MANAGEMENT SERVICES TO AMEND AND APPROPRIATE THE \$100,000 FOR THE LOVE YOUR BLOCK GRANT AWARD IN BOTH REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 & 2025-2026 OPERATING BUDGET.

WHEREAS, The Bloomberg Center for Public Innovation, under Johns Hopkins University, established the Love Your Block (LYB) Grant program awarding \$100,000 to each City participating; and

WHEREAS, the City submitted a LYB funding application to The Bloomberg Center for Public Innovation and was awarded \$100,000 in grant funding; and

WHEREAS, The Bloomberg Center for Public Innovation requires that the City designate a signatory authority to execute project agreements and certifications for the project.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and City Council hereby accept grant funding for The Bloomberg Center for Public Innovation - Love Your Block (LYB) Grant in the amount of \$100,000 and designate the City Manager, or her designee, as the signatory authority to execute all agreements and certifications in support of the LYB Grant.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance & Management Services is hereby authorized to amend and appropriate \$100,000 for the LYB award in both revenues and expenditures to the FY 2024-2025 & FY 2025-2026 Operating Budget.

SECTION 3. The City Council finds this Resolution is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in that the activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA

applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty, as in this case, that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
