

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-229

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO 1 TO THE GOODS PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH WILLIAM SCOTSMAN INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,132.62 TO ACCOMMODATE A PRICE ADJUSTMENT TO INCLUDE PREVAILING WAGES ON THE PURCHASE OF A MODULAR BUILDING FOR ANIMAL SERVICES, AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES TO AMEND THE PURCHASE ORDER TO WILLIAM SCOTSMAN, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$440,000.00.

WHEREAS, The City of San Bernardino entered into a Regional Partnership Agreement with the Cities of Colton, Fontana, Grand Terrace, Loma Linda and Rialto to house animals from their cities at the animal shelter located at 333 Chandler Place in the City of San Bernardino and

WHEREAS, The City of San Bernardino, entered into a contract with William Scotsman, Inc. to purchase a modular office building to expand office space to adequately serve the needs of the community, and

WHEREAS, The original quote for purchase and subsequent contract did not include the costs for prevailing wages, and

WHEREAS, The City of San Bernardino, wishes to proceed with the purchase of the modular office building to include the additional costs for prevailing wages

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. Authorize the City Manager to Execute Amendment #1 to the Goods Purchase Agreement with William Scotsman, Inc. in the amount of \$13,132.62 to accommodate a price adjustment to include prevailing wages on the purchase of a modular building for animal services.

SECTION 3. Authorize the Director of Finance and Management Services to amend the purchase order to William Scotsman, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$440,000.00.

SECTION 4. CEQA. The Mayor and City Council finds this Resolution is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in that the activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty, as in this case, that there is no possibility

that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA.

SECTION 6. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
