

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-259**

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE AGENCY DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES TO AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2022/23 GENERAL FUND OPERATING BUDGET REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES BY \$450,000 FOR THE PURCHASE OF STREETLIGHT POLE REPLACEMENT SERVICES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Bernardino values keeping City streetlights operating efficiently; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is supportive of all efforts to properly maintain, modernize and upgrade City infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, the City recognizes that keeping our streetlight poles operating smoothly will promote safer communities and encourage economic investment.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

**SECTION 2.** The Mayor and City Council adopt resolution No. 2022-259 authorizing the Agency Director of Administrative Services to amend the FY 2022/23 General Fund Operating Budget in the amount of \$450,000; and

**SECTION 3.** The Mayor and City Council authorize the City Manager to execute Maintenance Services Agreement with Yunex, LLC., for streetlight pole replacement services; and

**SECTION 4.** The Mayor and City Council authorize the Agency Director Administrative Services to amend the FY22/23 budget in the amount of \$450,000 to the Public Works Operations and Maintenance General Fund; and

**SECTION 5.** The Mayor and City Council authorize the Agency Director of Administrative Services to issue a purchase order to Yunex, LLC., in the amount not to exceed \$450,000

**SECTION 6.** The Mayor and City Council find this Resolution is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in that the activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty, as in this case, that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA.

**SECTION 7.** Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

**SECTION 8.** Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
