## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-257**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO, CALIFORNIA, **AGENCY AUTHORIZE** THE DIRECTOR ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES TO ALLOCATE FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000 FROM THE CULTURAL **IMPACT** DEVELOPMENT FUND FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR **CITY-WIDE** OF **MEMORIAL PLAQUES AND STATUES FOR FY 22-23** 

**WHEREAS,** the City collects Cultural Development Construction Fee pursuant to San Bernardino Municipal Code Chapter 15.57 to promote fine art and cultures; and

**WHEREAS,** the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department and the Arts and Historical Preservation have developed a maintenance repair plan for the memorial plaques and statues throughout the City that are in need of repair; and

WHEREAS, three priority projects have been identified by the Department and Commission: granite stone for Vietnam memorial and Martin Luther King Statue in front of City Hall, and the angel statue at La Plaza Park; and

**WHEREAS,** the allocation of Cultural Development Impact Funds to the repair of Citywide memorial plaques and statues will show respect and pride for the achievements and historical moments they represent.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

**SECTION 2.** The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the Agency Director of Administrative Services to allocate \$25,000 in the Cultural Development Impact Fund for city wide the repair of City-wide memorial plaques and statues for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.

**SECTION 3.** The Mayor and City Council finds this Resolution is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in that the activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty, as in this case, that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA.

**SECTION 4.** Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

**SECTION 5.** Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
