

FIRST AMENDMENT TO
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
WITH THE PM GROUP

This First Amendment ("First Amendment") to the Professional Services Agreement dated October 20, 2021 ("Agreement") is made and entered into by and between the CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO ("CITY") and THE PM GROUP ("Vendor") as of the last date set forth below.

1. Vendor performs **Design, Print and Mail Preparation of City of San Bernardino PRCSB Brochure of Activities for FY2021/2022** under the Agreement. Now, the CITY and Vendor wish to amend the Agreement to increase the compensation from \$67,635 to \$97,635. The expiration date shall be extended to August 31, 2022.

2. Section 4a of the Agreement is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"Subject to paragraph 4(b) below, the City shall pay for such services in accordance with the Schedule of Charges set forth in Exhibit "B," for an amount up to \$97,635. This amount is to cover all related costs, and the City will not pay any additional fees for expenses, except those noted in the following."

3. Section 6 of the Agreement is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"This Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and continue through the expiration date of August 31, 2022. The City reserves the right to extend this Agreement for up to four (4) additional one (1) year periods. Such extension shall only be valid if effectuated in writing by the City."


4. Except as modified by this First Amendment, all provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect for the term thereof.

5. This First Amendment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
