RESOLUTION NO.2022-258

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE VISUAL AND PERFORMANCE ART GRANT AWARDS TO WINNING APPLICATIONS (\$72,700) AND FURTUR GRANT OPTIONS FOR NON 501c(3) APPLICANTS (\$25,300) FOR \$98,000 IN TOTAL.

WHEREAS, the City collects Cultural Development Construction Fees pursuant to San Bernardino Municipal Code Chapter 15.57 to promote fine arts and Cultures; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council accepted the recommendation of the Arts and Historical Preservation Commission of the City of San Bernardino to approve the allocation of Cultural Development funds to support the Visual, Performing, and Literary Arts grant to reengage the art community in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department and the Arts and Historical Preservation Commission received and evaluated nine grant applications; and

WHEREAS, the Arts and Historical Preservation Commission met and voted to award seven applicants, with 501c(3) status, a cumulative total of \$72,700 and allocate the remaining balance of \$25,300 for future grant, non 501c(3), applicants for a total of \$98,000.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.
- **SECTION 2.** Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the Agency Director of Administrative Services to allocate funds from the Community Development Impact to account and distribute awards for the Visual, Performing, and Literary Arts Grant.
- **SECTION 3.** The Mayor and City Council finds this Resolution is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in that the activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty, as in this case, that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA.
- **SECTION 4.** Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
