- V. Project Description/Need Statement (include plan for collaboration with a local business if you have one)

Purpose and Goal: **(P)** To highlight the importance of **Mental Health Awareness** while providing information on free resources and support groups for men and women of color suffering from mental illness. **(G)** To provide a 12-week program to participants interested in learning how to incorporate art and poetry as a therapeutic outlet. The program will begin with our kickoff art exhibit event scheduled for **Thursday, March 2, 2023** from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm located at 555 N Arrowhead Ave San, Bernardino Ca 92401. Exhibit is free and will be open to the public. Our workshops will begin that following week and will be held once a week every Thursday from 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm. Each workshop will be conducted by a different presenter. Light refreshments and materials will be provided for all registered participants during workshops. Workshops will be free to the public as well.

Presenters will share their experiences and provide participants will information and tools on how art and poetry can support mental health in a time of need. The final event will be a poetry/art event titled, ***(Liberation with Words)*** to be held **Saturday, May 20th, 2023** from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm. The event will consist of participants from the workshop along with the presenters. One participant will have a chance at receiving a \$1000 cash prize for their poem if selected by judges. The event will be free for the public. The poetry component will be overseen by LUE Productions an entertainment company based out of the Inland Empire. LUE Productions stands for Launching Unique Entertainment, and has been coordinating events, providing platforms for artists, and entertainment for the City of San Bernardino for over 15 years.

We will be using the supportive services and collaboration with The African American health Coalition, Lue Productions, Off the Chain Alliance and MHE Productions.

Their expertise and connections with the community will support us in reaching our target audience and bring in the resources for a successful event.

VI. There's no charge for events or workshops everyone is free. We anticipate an overall total of 1000 or more participants. There's a total of 12 classes

Art exhibit will be a total of 3 hours. Final poetry event will be a total of 3 hours with live performances.

VII. The event and workshops are designed to help and assist individuals suffering from mental illness challenges. To provide a 12-week program to participants interested in learning how to incorporate art and poetry as a therapeutic outlet.
